

- b) Candidate's Affidavit - Each candidate for public office must execute and file one Candidate's Affidavit with his or her nomination papers. The affidavit must be signed in the presence of a person empowered to take acknowledgments (such as a notary public). The Candidate's Affidavit is printed on a separate form, DSBE-PBCA (2/07), for use with DSBE PB-G Nomination Papers. Among other things, the form requests the candidate's election district. "Election District" means the ward, precinct, division or district in which the candidate is registered to vote.
- c) Statement of Financial Interests - Each candidate, except candidates for the offices of President of the United States, Vice-President of the United States and Representative in Congress, must submit with their nomination papers a copy of their completed Statement of Financial Interests (Form SEC-1). The original copy of the Statement of Financial Interests must be filed with the State Ethics Commission. 10. WHERE TO FILE:

Nomination papers for all state-level offices must be filed with the Secretary of the Commonwealth at Room 210 North Office Building, Harrisburg, PA 17120. All nomination papers, required affidavits and filing fees must be **RECEIVED** in Room 210 North Office Building no later than 5:00 P.M. on August 1, 2008.

11. FILING FEES:

Filing fees for nomination papers are the same as the filing fees required for nomination petitions for the same office. Filing fees must be presented with the nomination papers and must be paid by **CERTIFIED CHECK** or **MONEY ORDER** payable to the "Commonwealth of Pennsylvania."
